Uptown Jackson Revitalization Organization Achieves Associate Tier Status with Missouri Main Street Connection

We are proud to recognize that Uptown Jackson Revitalization Organization has been selected as a new Associate community with Missouri Main Street Connection (MMSC). MMSC is a statewide non-profit organization designed to help Missouri communities preserve their historic commercial districts through economic revitalization. MMSC currently provides services and trainings to over 160 communities across the state. MMSC has empowered downtown revitalization in Missouri communities since 2006, resulting in over \$1 billion of private and public investments, the creation of 834 net new businesses, and the development of 4,109 net new jobs in Main Street communities.

MMSC State Director, Gayla Roten said, "The Uptown Jackson Revitalization Organization has been demonstrating the impact of Main Street and advocating preservation education in uptown Jackson with great success! The Main Street organization has been hard at work implementing historic preservation-based economic development in downtown Jackson while creating a place for people to gather, live, and work in downtown Jackson." During 2021, Uptown Jackson Revitalization Organization has had \$461,382 total investment in downtown, 22 net new jobs, and 2,272 volunteer hours.

Associate communities are those working toward being recognized as a nationally Accredited Main Street community by Missouri Main Street and National Main Street Center. The Associate Tier will help prepare the community for meeting the standards to be a Nationally and State Accredited community. At the Associate Tier level, the community is seeing an increase in the economic value of the downtown and is making progress to achieve an active and vibrant downtown revitalization organization.
