Salisbury Completes Services from the Community Empowerment Grant program

Salisbury Main Street has completed the services from the cost-sharing Community Empowerment Grant that provided training, mentoring, and technical services to the local revitalization organization. The service grant is provided by Missouri Main Street Connection, Inc. (MMSC).

MMSC staff facilitated input from the community through a Town Hall and community survey and worked with community leaders to identify and provide tools to implement these ideas. Additionally, consultants provided branding, design, and economic development services, giving the organization a roadmap to implement for years to come. MMSC State Director Gayla Roten noted, "The locally led organization, Salisbury Main Street, has truly shown a strong desire to comprehensively revitalize downtown Salisbury using the Main Street Approach™. These volunteers have taken the resources given throughout the entirety of this service grant and diligently worked to put processes in place to implement the community's ideas for a more vibrant downtown Salisbury. We look forward to seeing the continued growth of Salisbury Main Street and downtown Salisbury."

The goal of the grant is the development of a sustainable, volunteer-based economic development organization focused on using the Main Street Approach™ to revitalize downtown. The Community Empowerment Grant is a 60/40 matching service grant. The total value of the grant in training and mentoring services is \$30,800, with MMSC providing 60% of the match for services. Missouri Main Street Connection staff provided specialized training services to implement the Main Street principles to assist Salisbury Main Street in identifying and developing economic development projects downtown.

Salisbury is designated as a community in the Affiliate Tier in the Missouri Main Street Tier Structure, which ranks progression on standards established by Main Street America. It is Missouri Main Street Connection's goal and hope that Salisbury Main Street continues to grow as an organization to continue to move up the Tier Structure.
